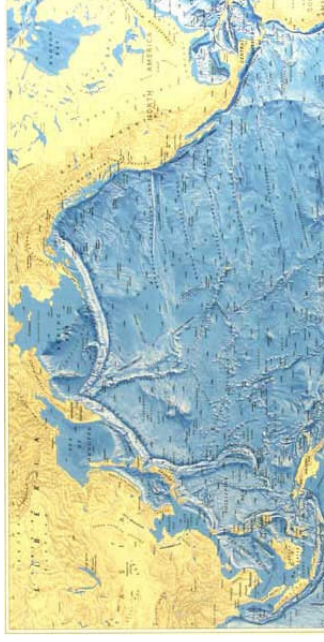

Scholars from Asia and the United States will gather for three days in Berkeley, California to discuss issues and efforts of reconciliation from their varied cultural perspectives.

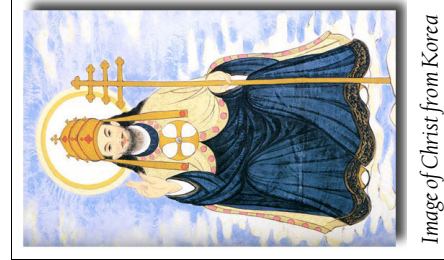


Image of Christ from Korea

at Church Divinity School of the Pacific

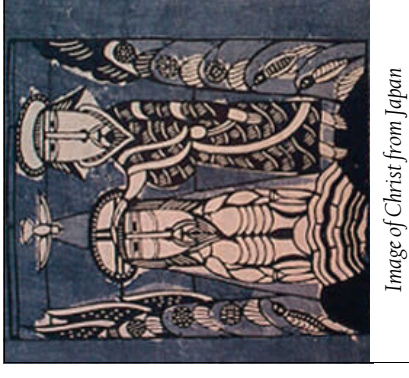


Image of Christ from Japan
